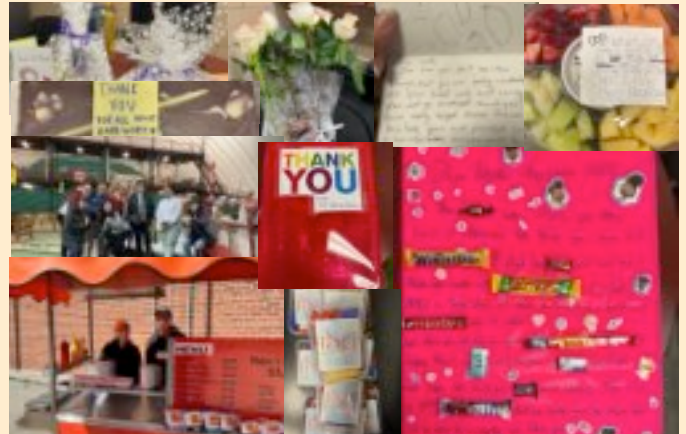
What We Learned
